- 1981 eerste integrated school
- 1987: NICIE: Northern Ireland Council for Integrated Education
- 1989: NICIE erkend door overheid
- Nu: 65 scholen in totaal = 7% van de schoolgaande kinderen
- Initiatief kwam van ouders!

Integrated Schools - Aanpak

- Kinderen van verschillende culturen en godsdiensten, Katholiek en Protestant, leren en leven dagelijks samen op één school.
- Samen feesten vieren
Alle leerlingen vieren alle feesten mee: Ramadan, St Patrick, Kerstmis...
De kinderen maakten een gebed dat voor iedereen goed voelt
- Praten! Oplossing: praten over emoties, eerst is men kwaad op elkaar. Na lang praten is men nog kwaad maar niet meer op elkaar.



- Opleiding van leraren in Noord-Ierland: 1/3 gaat over relaties met ouders



“Integrated Education may not be the answer to the problems which have faced Northern Ireland for so long.

Educating children together in a shared institution, where they can see it is possible for teachers, staff and governors coming from both of the major traditions to work together in harmony, despite strongly held personal beliefs, must hold out some hope for the future.”
